
# AMEC African Methodist Episcopal Church

Originated and grew out of the FREE AFRICAN SOCIETY

Founded 1787 by Richard Allen In Philadelphia, PA



### **AFRICAN**

- Founded by African Americans, by and for newly freed SLAVES, fueled by racial discrimination.
- Forced to seek a new location for worship due to unchristian conduct and other acts by St. George Methodist Episcopal Church of Philadelphia. (They were considered a nuisance and pulled off their knees, while in the act of prayer, and ordered to sit in the back).
- They purchased an old BLACKSMITH SHOP hence the "ANVIL" logo "TO SHOW THAT MANY HAVE HAMMERED ON IT; AND IT IS STILL ABLE TO SHAPE MANY RELIGIOUS DESTINIES."

# **METHODIST**

- Adopted Methodism polity, faith statements, liturgy, and music.
- Embraces Wesleyan Quadrilateral (Four Alls).
- Practices methodical worship, liturgies, and litanies.
- Litany includes CALL TO WORSHIP, HYMNS, PRAYERS,
- SCRIPTURE READINGS, DECALOGUE, SERMON, INVITATION TO DISCIPLESHIP, STATEMENT OF FAITH, AND HYMNS.
- Liturgy was <u>formal and repetitive</u> to teach the faith and doctrine to newly freed slaves who were unable to read.

#### **EPISCOPAL**

- Episcopal polity (not denomination) indicates BISHOP led.
- 20 Bishops are assigned to and responsible for one of 20 Episcopal Districts around the globe.
- Authority flows from the assigned Presiding Bishop/Prelate, to PRESIDING ELDERS, who are appointed by the Bishop to oversee the ministry of the (Bishop-appointed) PASTORS.
- Church governance consists of Quarterly, Annual, and General (4 Year) Conferences.

## CHURCH/CLERGY

- PASTORS are ordained as Deacons (1st order) and Elders (2nd and terminal order). Pastors are further classified as **Itinerant** (eligible to "travel" to pastor any congregation) or **Local** (eligible to serve one specific local congregation) Elders.
- ITINERANT Elders must complete Master level theological degrees before assignment to a church
- SACRED WRITING is the Christian BIBLE; GOVERNING document is the AMEC DOCTRINE AND DISCIPLINE; Primary MINISTERIAL/LITURGICAL DOCUMENT is the AMEC HYMNAL.

## **THEOLOGY**

- TRINITY: MONOTHEISTIC GOD *manifested* in three persons Father, Son (Jesus) and the Holy Spirit .
- CREATION: Triune God created heaven, earth, and all living things.
- SOTERIOLOGY: Salvation (for fallen humanity) reconciliation with the Godhead (Trinity) and eternal life <u>is available only through acceptance of Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior</u>.
- AMEC THEOLOGY is embodied in the APOSTLE'S CREED.

#### Additional Info

- The AMEC places great importance on <u>higher education</u>; it has <u>founded</u> and <u>maintains several colleges</u>, <u>schools</u>, <u>and seminaries</u>.
- THE AMEC IS ALSO A STRONG ADVOCATE FOR RACIAL, SOCIAL, POLITICAL AND ECONOMIC JUSTICE.
- REVERENDS HELEN HUNTER, DMIN, MDIV. AND OZETTA KIRBY, MA, MED. are Ordained Elders in the Arizona-New Mexico Conference of the Fifth Episcopal District, encompassing 14 states, from Missouri to California.
